Current major programs

Co-supervised Postgraduate students:

- Majority PhDs
- Some Masters and Honours
- Mostly Australian universities, a few overseas – Japan, US, China, India, UK
- Ad hoc recruitment at present

Undergraduate Vacation Studentships:

- Typically ~ 15 students pa
- Paid (CSOF 1.1)
- Not just ATNF Science projects
- This year on 4 sites



Other programs

Women in Engineering scholars:

- Currently trial program with Macquarie Uni, 2 students
- Scope for more at other institutions

Offer pending for an **Indigenous Research Fellowship**:

New CSIRO program

 Fulltime PhD program for Indigenous student, employed as staff member

Supporting other Uni programs:

• eg Macquarie Uni PACE program



Co-supervised students

2022-23 Annual report:

- Supervised 30 PhD, 4 MRes, 1 Hons students
- Students from 16 different universities incl 4 international (China, Japan, UK, USA)
- 9 PhDs, 3 MRes, 2 Hons theses awarded

Co-supervised students as of October 2023

- 34 students from 17 different universities (4 international)
- 14 Female: 20 Male
- 30 PhD
- 3 MRes
- 1 Hons
- 2 students have joined since June, 2 have submitted PhDs, 1 has had MRes accepted

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2023-24 Undergraduate Vacation Studentships

- 20 November 2023 2 February 2024 core dates
- 14 students + 1 Women in Engineering from 10 universities
- ~50:50 gender split
- Placements in Kensington, Tidbinbilla, Parkes, Black Mountain & Marsfield
- Observing trip to Narrabri



Postgraduate student program review

Student survey feedback

- 25 responses
- Satisfaction ratings (1 poor 5 excellent) all questions had average of > 4.0
- Average for overall experience 4.60
- "Would you recommend to other students? Average 4.88
- Strong interest in Student Symposium need to find suitable dates
- Rolling out dedicated MatterMost channel for student discussion/issues

- Several students participated in ATNF Radio School
- Plan student symposium in 2024 students to lead
- Review student benefits, eg travel funding
- Explore other options, eg Industry PhDs
