




# Life changes of the local residents around the FAST site

I would like to acknowledge the natives around the FAST site for their relocations, which was the prerequisite that made the gigantic telescope come into being.



❖ Site selection: 1994 – 2004




Rendong Nan's team, worldwide radio astronomers and the local residents of Dawodang





- Rising the feed cabin




### Radio Quiet Zone











#### New relocations

- In the 5km-radio-quiet area (including parts of Pingtang and Luodian)
- ❖ 5000+ residents relocated to the *Astronomy Town*.





### Impacts

#### On the other infrastructure:

- Airport: The proposal of civil airport of Luodian County has to be canceled.
- \* Traffic network: block original multiple roads, one road is allowed only to the FAST site.


#### On people's daily life:

- The signal strengths received by mobile phones:
  - No signals at all in the innermost area (<5 km)</li>
  - Weaker than previous (5 km<d<30 km)</p>
- Number limit for daily tourists:
  - Economic development may be constrained due to inconvenience in the RQZ.

#### Nearest town to the FAST







### Specific benefits

#### For the original residents at Dawodang:

- Traffic isolation disappeared
- New spacious and modern houses relocated
- Incomes increased significantly
- Education for children gets better

#### For the local people in the RQZ:

- Allocated apartments
- Start-up opportunities from tourism
- Poverty reliefs in the full area

### General benefits

#### Eduction popularisation:

- More primary and middle schools built
- 100% educated children from the remote villages

#### Employments:

- Hotels and lodges: 6 -> 137;
- ♣ Restaurants: 8 -> 288;
- ❖ 1200+ jobs were offered to the local people.

#### Annual Incomes:

- ♣ Individual: ¥ 20k+ (\$ 4k+)
- ♣ Agritainment: ¥ 200k+ (\$ 40k+)
- ❖ Start-up factories: ¥ 1M+ (\$ 200k+)

#### Cultural promotion:

For **Bouyei** minority: languages, festivals, buildings, food, costumes, etc.
