## TRANSPORT

The most convenient airport is Athens (I know little about the Kalamata airport that is closer).

For transport options and details check in the website.

If there are many people arriving on Monday (as has happened in previous workshops) the LOC will organise a free bus for transport to the hotels in Tripoli. We cannot guarantee this at present and until we have enough registrants to make it cost effective.

If you arriving earlier and intend to spend a few days in Athens, consider getting the Metro back to the airport on Monday afternoon to take advantage of the free bus. Please let us know in your registration or via an email to the LOC.

## EXCURSION(S)

In previous workshops, on the Saturday after the workshop (this time 3 June) the LOC has organised excursions to places of interest nearby, primarily in the Peloponnese.
